It also includes modern memorials such as the Wall of Honor, which memorializes all of the plantation’s slave residents; as well as the Field of Angels, a section of the field “gated” with granite slabs memorializing 2,200 Louisiana slave children. Louisiana’s only slavery-focused plantation museum.
